#### TRAINING TO USE THE DEFIBRILLATOR SITUATED AT THE VILLAGE HALL

By having a defibrillator in your community and by training people in CPR, you can play an important part in saving more lives. A cardiac arrest happens when there is a problem with the heart's electrical rhythm, stopping it from pumping blood properly to the rest of the body. It can happen anywhere and at any time. It can happen at home, in the playground or in the street. The person will collapse, stop breathing and become unconscious. Chances of survival decrease the longer it takes for someone to step in. By training your community in life saving skills, if the worst happens, they'll be there to step in and give someone the best possible chance of survival. For Donyatt, there will be a Defibrillator Training Course on **Saturday 27th November 2021 in the Village Hall 9.30am – 12.30pm.** No need to book, just come along. Refreshments will be served.
