- **The 'Lovery' Trophy for Cookery**
to the exhibitor with most points in classes 46 - 63.
- **The Craft Trophy**
to the exhibitor with most points in classes 64 - 72.
- **The Photography Award**
to the exhibitor with most points in classes 73 - 77.
- **The Best All Rounder cup** to the exhibitor with most points overall.
- **Children's prize money.**
- **Certificate for 'Best in Show'** for the best entry in the whole show.
- **Certificate for 'Best Floral Art'** for the best entry in classes 41 - 45.

RULES OF ENTRY

1. **No** exhibitor shall have more than one entry in each class.
2. All exhibits to be grown or made by exhibitors unless otherwise stated. No entries to have been previously exhibited at this show. Entries not according to schedule will be disqualified.
3. All exhibits to be staged by 10:45am on the morning of the show. The hall will open on Saturday 20th August between 7pm and 9pm and from 8:30am on Sunday 21st August. Judging will start at 11am sharp.
4. No exhibits to be cut or removed prior to 4:30pm on the day of the show. All exhibits to be removed by 5pm.
5. The show committee will issue exhibitor cards to be placed alongside each entry. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their correct placement.
6. Objections to any award to be made by 3pm on the day of the show and must be accompanied by a deposit of £5 to the show committee: such deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
7. Entry fees for classes 1 to 77 - 50p per entry for first three entries, further entries 25p each. Children's classes FREE.
8. Entry forms and fees to The Old Dairy, Donyatt. Walk through the archway of Smithy Farm, the property to the left of the pub, and The Old Dairy's postbox will be seen to your right.
9. Children's classes – the age of the child is taken as the age of that child as they will be on 15th August 2022. Prizes for Children's classes: First – £2, Second – £1, Third – 50p.
10. Closing date for entries – Monday 15th August 2022. No entries accepted after this date.
11. Points to be awarded for all classes: First - 3 points, Second - 2 points, Third - 1 point.
12. All trophies to be held for one year. Awards to be presented at 4:00pm on the day of the show.

An arrangement in a retro container.

Space allowed 48cm wide x 48cm deep.

Judged from the front.

44. **The Modern Wedding**

An arrangement in a jam jar.

Space allowed 25cm wide x 25cm deep.

45. **In Time And Space**

A miniature futuristic exhibit.

Space allowed 10cm wide x 10cm deep.

NB: No artificial plant material to be used in any class.

All exhibits must be the sole unaided work of the competitor.

All classes may be brought ready assembled.

Height is optional unless otherwise stated.
